

MULTIPLE ENTRY VISITOR'S VISA

A Multiple Entry Visitor's Visa is valid for several entries into Indonesia and is available for non-work purposes that covers all aspects relevant to government, tourism, socio-culture and business, such as: intergovernmental cooperation, tourism, family/social, short course, journalism (requires authorisation), non-commercial filmmaking, business, lecture/seminar (requires authorisation) and meeting, for a maximum period of 1 (one) year. Each visit may not exceed 60 (sixty) days. Multiple Entry Visitor's Visa is not a working visa and cannot be extended.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Forms to be completed in duplicate with 2 (two) passport-size photos and submitted with your passport.
2. Passport must be valid (for traveling to Indonesia) at least 1 (one) year at the date of entry into Indonesia.
3. **For business purposes:**
 - a. a covering letter from the counterpart in Indonesia and/or the company in New Zealand for those who are invited by their counterpart in Indonesia; or
 - b. a covering letter from the company in New Zealand for those who are assigned by their company in New Zealand; or
 - c. a covering letter from the person themselves if they are self-employed;
 - d. all three types of letters above must explain the position of the applicant, the purpose of the visit and duration of stay. If deemed necessary, a guarantee of the availability of funds to cover living expenses while in Indonesia will be requested.

For social/cultural visits: a covering letter from the sponsor (e.g. the employer, educational institution) or the people in Indonesia (family, relatives) to be visited, explaining the position of the applicant, the purpose of the visit and the duration of stay. If deemed necessary, a guarantee of the availability of funds to cover living expenses while in Indonesia will be requested.

4. A Multiple Entry Visitor's Visa will be issued for up to 60 (sixty) days for each visit, for a maximum period of 1 (one) year.
5. Copies of ticket or itinerary from travel agents confirming purchase of either a return ticket or a ticket to a destination beyond Indonesia. Open dated tickets are acceptable.
6. Fees for Multiple Entry Visitor's Visa: **NZ\$ 155.00**. Please send money order, bank cheque or company cheque.
7. Please provide a **self-addressed signature required courier pack** for your passport/documents to be returned.
8. The Entry must be made within 90 (ninety) days from the date of issue.

Please note:

1. The Visas issued by the Indonesian Embassy are not applicable for the visit to three following regions: Aceh, Maluku and Irian Jaya/Papua. Applicants who wish to visit these regions must obtain special authorization from Indonesian authorities. Visitors who enter those three regions without special permission will be liable to prosecution under Indonesian law.
2. Entry to Indonesia for foreigners granted visas by the Indonesian Embassy remains subject to the approval of the immigration officer at all Indonesian immigration checkpoints (airports, seaports and land-borders).
