

## SINGLE ENTRY VISITOR'S VISA

A Single Entry Visitor's Visa is given to persons, other than the exempted foreign nationals ([Free Visa for Short Visit](#)), who intend to have a visit for non-work purposes that covers all aspects relevant to government, tourism, socio-culture and business, such as: intergovernmental cooperation, tourism, family/social, short course, journalism (requires authorisation), non-commercial filmmaking (requires authorisation), business, lecture/seminar (requires authorisation), non-commercial exhibition and meeting, for a maximum period of 60 (sixty) days. A Single Entry Visitor's Visa is not a working visa and cannot be converted into any other type of visa.

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. Forms to be completed in duplicate with 2 (two) passport-size photos and submitted with your passport.
2. Copies of ticket or itinerary from travel agents confirming purchase of either a return ticket or ticket to a destination beyond Indonesia. Open dated tickets are acceptable.
3. Letters of credit / bank statements / copy of credit card to show proof of ability to cover living expenses.
4. Applicants who are not able to show proof of available funds may provide a letter from other applicants stating that they will be responsible to cover the applicant's expenses during their stay in Indonesia. The letter must be signed by the two parties.
5. Applications intend to travel for social/family visit and business visit have to produce supporting letter from their families/friends and their counterparts in Indonesia.
6. Passport must be valid at least 6 (six) months at the date of entry into Indonesia.
7. Fees for Single Entry Visitor's Visa: **NZ\$ 70.00**. Please send money order, bank cheque or company cheque.
8. Please provide a **self-addressed signature required courier pack** for your passport/documents to be returned.
9. Maximum period of stay for Single Entry Visitor's Visa is **60 (sixty) days** only.  
The visa must be used within 90 (ninety) days from the date of issue.
10. A Single Entry Visitor's Visa is issued for a single journey only.

**Please note:**

- \* The requirements are effective as from **14 May 2007**
  
- The Visas issued by the Indonesian Embassy are not applicable for the visit to three following regions: Aceh, Maluku and Irian Jaya/Papua. Applicants who wish to visit these regions must obtain special authorization from Indonesian authorities. Visitors who enter those three regions without special permission will be liable to prosecution under Indonesian law.
  
- Entry to Indonesia for foreigners granted visas by the Indonesian Embassy remains subject to the approval of the immigration officer at all Indonesian immigration checkpoints (airports, seaports and land-borders).
